Ann Parsley, 94, died March 7, 2021 at her home in Foley, Alabama. She was born May 1926 in a small farming community in central Indiana. Ann married her college sweetheart, Albert Parsley, in 1948. Together they raised two daughters, Cheryl and Theresa.

Ann's family valued education. She attended Indiana University, earning her bachelor and master's degree from the Bloomington campus. Ann furthered her educational ambitions by obtaining her educational specialist degree at Purdue University. She retired from LaPorte, Indiana Community Schools as an elementary school principal. In 1987 Ann was named Indiana Elementary School Principal of the year. In 1988 she was recognized as a National Distinguished Principal. A proud advocate for early childhood education, Ann helped to establish preschool and kindergarten programs in her area. She served on numerous boards, including the Youth Service Bureau, was a Charter member of LaPorte Hospital Auxiliary, LaPorte Area Hospice Board, and Juvenile Aid Association. Ann was active in the Presbyterian church both in LaPorte and Foley as an elder, Christian education, and in the Presbyterian Women.

She was preceded in death by her parents Lloyd and Elizabeth, siblings Mary Helen and George, and a husband Al. Ann is survived by her two children, Cheryl (Rick) and Theresa, grandchildren Heather (Jason), Erica (Julio), Elizabeth, and great grandson Brody, Emiliano, and Nicolás.
