



Mr. Bobby Ray Herndon

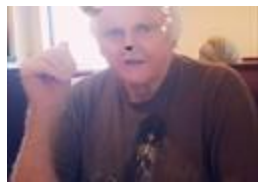
May 7, 1941 - January 12, 2022
