George Larry Hunt, a native of Ashland, Kentucky and resident of Bayou La Batre, Alabama for the past 37 years, died Wednesday, July 10, 2024, at the age of 79. He graduated from Logan Hills High School in 1963. He then completed his Machinist Mate, Class A course at the US Naval Training Center in 1964 and went on to graduate from the US Naval Submarine School later that year. George also completed courses at the US Naval Nuclear Power School and then served his country in the Vietnam War until 1970. He moved from Ohio to Alabama working for a company called Manpower, where he helped jobseekers connect with employers. He sold life insurance for a time and married Sandra Bryant in July of 1987. He eventually began working for Benders Shipbuilding as an Electrician. He finally retired from Ingalls Shipbuilding as an Electrician Foreman.

George and Sandy enjoyed many years of memories with family, traveling to Cheaha State Park, fishing in the Gulf of Mexico and camping on Petit Bois Island.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Jane Parker Hunt, his father, George Harrison Hunt, and his sister, Patricia "Pattie" Hunt.
