John Martin Haaseth, age 85, died and went to heaven on Friday, April 30, 2021. John was born on April 27, 1936, in Pontiac, Michigan. He was married to his wife, Arlin, for 51 years.

John was a proud Air Force veteran and worked in the boating industry on the Mississippi Gulf Coast for many years. He was a lay leader in the Lutheran Church, Boy Scout leader, beekeeper, wooden boat enthusiast, family man, and consummate do-it-yourselfer. During his life John donated over 250 units of blood (the equivalent of 25 people) to the Red Cross.
