Monaletta Jane Erichsen McCracken, a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away peacefully at her home in Mobile, Alabama on Saturday, April 12, 2025, at the age of 85. Born and raised in Aberdeen, South Dakota, Momy carried the warmth of her Midwestern roots wherever life took her.

A 1958 graduate of Central High School in Aberdeen, Momy went on to train as an X-ray technician at Aberdeen General Hospital. In 1960, she married her high school sweetheart, Bill McCracken, in Lakeland, Florida — beginning a devoted partnership that would span 64 years.

Momy is survived by her loving husband, Bill; her son Scott (late wife Vicki) of Portland, Oregon; her daughter Dana (late husband Mark) of Mobile, Alabama; eight grandchildren; and eleven great-grandchildren.

Momy will be remembered most for her kindness, generosity, and deep sense of hospitality. Whether she was hosting family dinners, baking and sharing her famous cinnamon sourdough bread, or preparing meals for those in need, she gave from the heart. Her home was always open — a place of comfort and

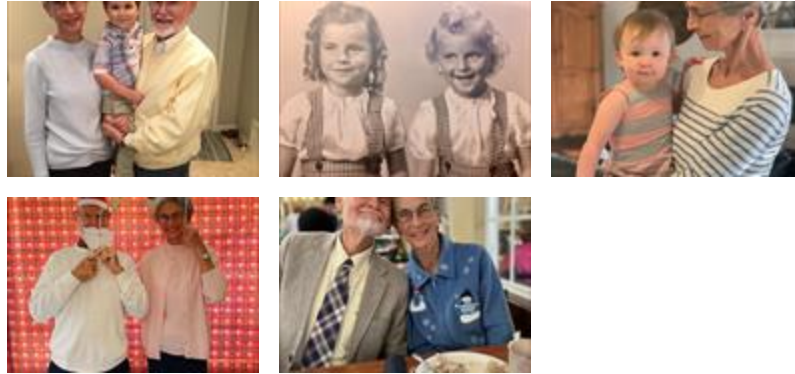

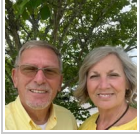
