



## Ms. Nancy Elaine Winfree

December 7, 1933 - June 24, 2021

Nancy Elaine Winfree was born in Charleston, West Virginia, December 7<sup>th</sup>, 1933 from the union of Howell L. Winfree, Sr and Bertha Irene Winfree. Her family moved to St. Petersburg, Florida when she was a child and she attended local schools there, ultimately graduating from St. Petersburg Junior College. From Junior college she traveled to Richmond, Virginia to attend and graduate from the Presbyterian Church's assembly's training school as a Director of Christian Education. She served Presbyterian churches in that capacity, in Memphis, Tennessee, as well as in Anniston and Mobile, Alabama. She subsequently received her bachelor's and Master's degrees from the University of South Alabama in social work and counseling. Thereafter she worked for the Mobile County Juvenile Court system as a counselor/caseworker and ultimately senior case manager. In retirement she served as a mentor, trainer and practicum director for counselors in training. She is survived by her brother, Howell Winfree, II of Ocala, Florida.
