Richard William “Rick” Lisenba, of Mobile, Alabama, passed away peacefully on July 18, 2024, surrounded by his family and closest friends. He was 60 years old. His family was the center of his world and he was a constant source of grounding, unwavering love, strength, and support. He began at the Mobile Water Works before joining the Army National Guard and serving his country as a medic in the Gulf War (Operation Desert Storm).
