Samuel Louis Weatherspoon, Jr., a native and resident of Mobile, passed away at his home on Wednesday, September 6, 2023, after a valiant battle against pancreatic cancer. Sam is survived by his wife Heather Lartigue Weatherspoon, son Michael Weatherspoon, daughter Kathryn (Nathan) Grant, father Samuel (Ethel) Weatherspoon, Sr., of Decatur, mother Faye Armstrong of Leeds, sisters Tracey (William) Campbell of Sumiton, and Debbie (David) McCurry of Theodore, niece Brittany (Drue) Davison & grand-nephew Bentley of Grand Bay, along with other family and friends.

Sgt. Weatherspoon was a twelve-year veteran of the Army National Guard 711 Signal Battalion. He was an avid NASCAR fan and enjoyed a career as an aircraft structures mechanic before retiring due to degenerative disc disease. Highlights of his retirement include winning a trip to Charlotte, North Carolina in 2014, where he raced go-karts with NASCAR driver Kevin Harvick, and placing fourth in the first Uno World Championship in Las Vegas in 2021.

The family will receive friends from 4 to 6 P.M. Tuesday, September 12, 2023, at Cottage Hill Memorial Funeral Home, 7158 Cottage Hill Road, Mobile, 36695.
