will continue to inspire us.

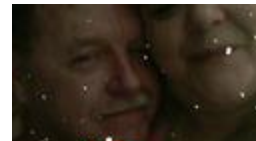

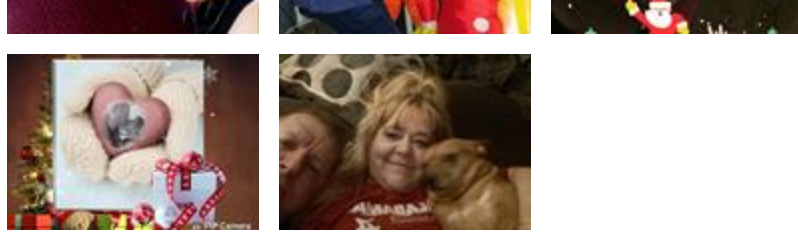
# Tribute Wall

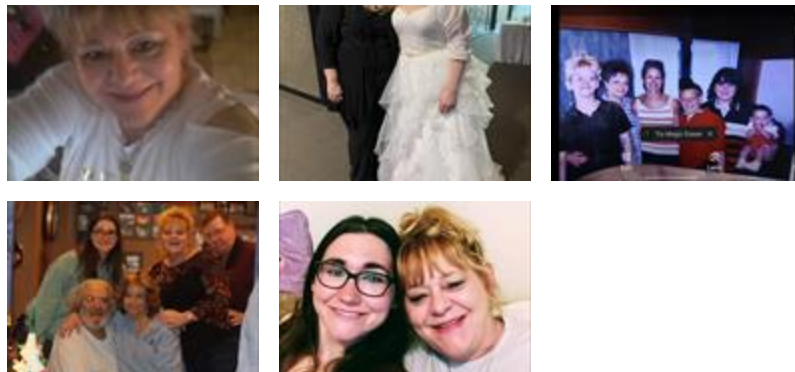
